Ultimate pass rates for National Physical Therapy Exam

As reported by Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy (FSBPT). Ultimate pass rate is reflected. Required 2-year average rate is 85%

First time pass rates for National Physical Therapy Exam

Results of the first attempt of graduates taking the NPTE. No required rate. For reporting purposes only.

Job Placement 1 Year after Graduation: the percentage of graduates who are licensed and sought employment in physical therapy. Required rate is 90% 2-year average.

Graduation Rates: calculated as the percentage of students who graduated within 150% of the program length. *Students who withdrew for non-academic reasons are excluded from the rate. Required rate is 60% 2-year average.
